TO RECEIVE REPORT FROM UGBOROUGH WEST

1. BUS SHELTER/S AT DAVID'S LANE PL21 0DW JUCTION WITH EXETER ROAD

To provide bus shelter to residents in the area akin to one situate at the bottom of Palace Lane/Exeter Road for passengers using local bus service west towards Ivybridge/Plymouth.

A. Update

- i. Plymouth City Council who were approached for initial contact due to PCC removal of all/majority of older style bus stops in area. PCC advised that JCDecaux but are not salvageable due to methods of extraction;
- ii. Writer has contacted Pittman UK who provide metal-based shelters for a quote for a one-off commission, be it installed or self-installed;
- iii. Need to consider land ownership of site be it DCC/SHDC or private individual for permission to site, if acceptable.

2. PARISH CLINIC

To provide. a clinic for residents of the UPC area, which include Ivybridge East Councillor and Ugborough & Ermington Councillor.

A. Update

- i. In the first instance discussions have been ongoing between local DCs to establish suitable arrangements, venues etc however suggest on hold until new year following feasibility study.
- ii. Suggestion id to produce leaflets showing area boundaries, reporting mechanism, local issues etc.

3. PARKING IN AND AROUND IVYBRIDGE RUGBY CLUB PL21 0LR

To discuss parking arrangements for users of IRC within the boundaries of the UPC area, which include Ivybridge East Councillor and Ugborough & Ermington Councillor.

A. Update

- i. In the first instance investigate what if any consultation/discussion has been effective in communicating current dangerous parking situation withing a mile radius of IRC, taking into account St Peters Lane, Godwell

Lane, the approach to and within Saxon Gate development and the station and the roads/lanes therein and around particularly on a Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

- ii. Discuss Highway Code Regulations and implications therein
 - 1. *242. You must not leave your vehicle or trailer in a dangerous position or where it causes any unnecessary obstruction of the road.*
 - 2. *243 Parking across a dropped or lowered kerb can stop people who need dropped kerbs to cross the road being able to do so.*

B. Requirements

- i. Education and self-governance after local D&C Police involvement.

4. USE OF MOTOR POWERED VEHICLES IN PEDESTRIAN LANE BETWEEN DAVID'S LANE AND GODWELL LANE

To discuss the apparent illegal use of motor-powered vehicle on the above pedestrian lane


A. Update
