These meetings have covered a variety of subject, including Tackling Drugs, Road Safety, Violence, Antisocial Behaviour, and most recently the launch of the “Criminal Justice and You”, This provides a very comprehensive online guide to assist, support and understand all aspect of the justice system.

We have also had monthly Teams meetings with Inspector Shardlow, who is the South Hams Sector Inspector, based at Totnes, who has kept us updated on local criminal activities.
