

Devon County Council (Various Roads, Ugborough) (20mph Limit) Order

Devon County Council make the following order in exercise of powers under sections 82, 83, 84, part IV of schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers

1. This order comes into force _____ and may be cited as “Devon County Council (Various Roads, Ugborough) (20mph Speed Limit) Order _____”
2. No person shall drive a vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the roads specified in the schedule
3. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011
4. The County of Devon (Various Roads, Ugborough) (Restricted Roads) Order 1998 is revoked in its entirety

The Schedule 20mph Speed Limit

The roads listed below are included for the entire length of public highway

- Donkey Lane
- Fore Street
- Lutterburn Street
- Parsonage Lane
- Seldons Close
- The Square
- Trinnicks Orchard
- Undertown
- Ware Hill

And the specified lengths of road listed below

- **Ennaton Cross to Lutterburn Street**

From its junction with Undertown to a point 222 metres north-east of that junction

- **Hillhead Cross to The Square along ZC152**

From its junction with Toby Cross to Ugborough Road a point 222 metres north-west of that junction

- **Parsonage Lane End to Haredon Cross**

From its junction with Parsonage Lane to a point 20 metres in a south-westerly of that junction

- **Toby Cross to Ugborough**

From its junction with Hillhead Cross to The Square along ZC152 to a point 124 metres west of that junction
