

Walk 1: Toby Cross, Hillhead, (Hookmoor Cross)
and back to Ugborough.

Distance 2- 2.5 miles. Time 0.75 –1hour.

This walk from Ugborough village square takes in the ridge road with views down towards the sea and across to Dartmoor.

From the conduit head NW uphill past the school and take the left hand fork up the hill past the school and Churchill Cottages. Just past Bowcombe Park on the left stop at the gate and admire the view down the valley, west towards the sea (towards Mothecombe). Just enjoy the silence here, even this close to the village.

Carry on up until you reach Toby Cross . Turn right at the cross-roads (to see your first view north to the slopes of Dartmoor: Western Beacon with Butterdon Hill behind and Ugborough Beacon to the east.

Carry on along the lane heading east until you reach Hillhead crossroads. and continue along the ridge road eastwards. As you go look out over dramatic views of Dartmoor which change colour depending on the light and weather conditions.

You may also hear the baying of the Dartmoor Hunt hounds at their kennels across the valley.

Also, on the right there are occasional views down to Ugborough church tower.

Carry on along the ridge road until, just after some mobile phone masts you reach the first lane on your right. Take this lane* and then right again after about 200 metres. ***OR**, carry on to Hookmoor Cross, with allotments on your left.

Turn right and follow the lane down, past Venn farm on your left then Whitehouse farm on your right. As you come downhill towards the village look towards the church tower and distant views of the sea at Mothecombe.

Continue downhill into Lutterburn Street and finally back up to the village square.
