

If you choose the field route (FP 24) climb the stile and follow the path across the field to cross the footbridge. On other side of the bridge bear left and head up the field. Take some time to stop occasionally to look back over Ugborough village, with views to the south west towards the sea. Go through the gate and bear slightly diagonally (right) across the field to the **stone** stile. Climb over and follow the path along the top of the field and down the track towards the gate and the entrance to the farm. Look out for the odd loose horse! Continue through the two farmyard gates and out into the lane where you then bear right, downhill to the main road.

If you choose the lane walk continue uphill past Whitehouse Farm and take the first lane on your right. Walk down, past the entrance to Venn Farm on your left and on to Ennaton Farm on your right. At the farm entrance you will see the other end of the footpath, coming in through the farmyard, had you taken the field route back in Lutterburn Lane. Continue on downhill to the main road.

Cross the main road (take care as this is a very busy road) to Well Cross, the lane at the left hand side of the garage.

Carry on up the lane, following it slowly up and round clockwise, past Oakpark Cross, as you near the top of the ridge. Carry on, clockwise, along the ridge road, again, taking time out at the occasional gate to stop and enjoy the views north towards Ugborough and Dartmoor beyond.

Follow the ridge road south-west wards past Higher Spriddlescombe Farm and turn into the first lane on your right at Dunwell Cross. Walk down the hill past Dunwell Farm.

Almost at the bottom of the hill there is a footpath on your right which cuts diagonally across the field*. If there are livestock in the field you may want to continue on the lane down to the main road. Cross the main road (take care as this a very busy road) into the lane opposite. Continue up this lane into Fore Street and back into the village square

* **Alternatively**, cross the field diagonally downhill to the style on the main road. Turn right and walk along the main road (CARE—very busy) and after xxxxx metres cross the road into Parsonage Lane. Carry on up the lane to the burial ground on the right and turn left to climb Donkey Lane back up into the square.

Ugborough Parish Walks **Walk 2: Ennaton, Well Cross, Oakpark Cross, Dunwell Cross and back to Ugborough**

A slightly longer walk with a few inclines. Distance around 3.5 miles. Time: about 1.5 to 2 hours. This is mainly a lane walk although some field walking is optional at the beginning and near the end.
