

At the farm entrance you will see the other end of the footpath, coming through the farmyard, had you taken the field\* route back in Lutterburn Lane.

Continue downhill to the main road. \*If you choose the field route climb the stile and walk across the field and cross the footbridge. After the bridge bear left up the side of the field. and through the gate. Bear slightly diagonally (right) across the field to the stone stile. Climb over and follow the path along the hedge and down through the two farmyard gates, out into the lane, and bear right downhill to the main road. Look out for the old lime kiln, now almost overgrown with vegetation, in the field opposite the farm house. Cross the main road (take care, a very busy road) and take the footpath sign-posted on the left side of the lane at the side of Ugborough Garage. Cross the field to the stile. Once over this stile aim across the middle of the field where the next stile is partially hidden behind a staggered hedge. Cross this stile and head slightly right (roughly the middle of the sloping field) to another stile. Climb the stile and descend the steps onto the main road. Take care here as this is the busy Loddiswell Road . Cross the road to the two stiles opposite (and slightly to your right) and climb over into the field. Follow the left hand edge up to a stone wall. Use the knotted rope and stone insets to climb the wall. Still keeping to the edge carry on to a metal gate, and out into the lane.

Turn right and follow the lane back to the Loddiswell Road At the main road turn right and after a few yards cross over the road and through the metal kissing gate. Carry on along the field edge up through the next metal kissing gate. Head across the field, through the metal farm gate. And head towards the far, right hand corner of the field to the kissing gate. Go through the gate and out into Spriddlescombe Lane (a green lane). Turn left and continue to where the green lane meets the tarmac lane. Bear left and continue along the ridge road. Take the footpath through a metal gate on your right, just before Higher Spriddlescombe Farm. Cross, down the field, to another stile at the bottom. Climb this stile and follow the track and stream down to Waterman's Farm. The footpath goes off to the left here and into a field. Take a route to your left around the edge of the field and through a gate into a second field. Cross this field, downhill, to another stile in the right hand corner. Cross this stile and head down to the last stile, on the right hand edge of the field. Climb over and into the surfaced lane and down to the main road. Turn right and walk along the main road (take care this is a busy road) for a few yards then cross over the road into Parsonage Lane. Follow Parsonage Lane up to the burial ground .Turn right into the sign-posted footpath (Donkey Lane). Follow this up to the church and back into the village square.

## Ugborough Parish Walks

**Walk 5: Ennaton Farm, Well Cross, Whetcombe Cross, Fowelscombe Gate, Spriddlescombe Lane, Waterman Lane and back to Ugborough.**

**Distance is around 5 miles and takes about 2.5 hours**



**START:** From the conduit turn into Lutterburn Street, past the Anchor and continue up into Lutterburn Lane. At around 50 metres past the last house on your right there is a public footpath on the right, up into the field, and here you have a choice of either continuing up the lane or climbing the steps up into the field\*. If you choose to continue up the lane then walk on past Whitehouse Farm for a few hundred metres and turn into the first lane on your right. Walk down past the entrance to Venn Farm and on to Ennaton Farm on your right.
