# UGBOROUGH PARISH COUNCIL MEETING Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> December 2025 at 7.30pm In the Bittaford Village Hall

#### **MINUTES**

## Questions from the public:

A member of the public raised the on-going issue of speeding traffic on the A3121 and the danger it presents not only for the junction at Parsonage Lane but for the other junctions at Haredon Cross, Ware and Ludbrook. He recounted numerous accidents he has witnessed and/or has knowledge of and noted that official records (recording only very serious or accidents with fatalities) do not reflect the real situation. It was also noted that the situation has a particular impact on horse riders attempting to cross the road. The installation of a speed restricted area on the same road at Ermington was raised as a possible precedence for action at Ugborough. It was agreed that the clerk would raise the matter with DCC Highways and this would be discussed further at the meeting in February.

# 25.141 Highways, Parish Paths and Transport

- 1. Donkey Lane update Council are awaiting a response from neighbouring landowners / tenants
- 2. Update from the Flood Working Group A statement detailing the proposed options from DCC Flood Officer and actions agreed by Council will be made available on the website and social media once approved by DCC.

The group have met and proposed the following actions which Council agreed:

Parsonage Lane - Cllr Hart will discuss the offer of support from DCC with the owner of the affected property and pass on the contact details for the owner to liaise direct with DCC. Ware – Cllr Hart will discuss the options recommended by DCC with the respective landowners and progress accordingly

**Lutterburn Street - Clerk to contact DCC and request:** 

- They consider further the upgrade of the current screen
- Assistance to establish a regular programme of clearing the grating, road sweeping, drain clearance and debris removal whilst the more intensive options are explored further

#### 25.142 Maintenance

- 1. The estimates for work to improve the safety of the slide were considered and it was agreed that the best value action would be to replace the equipment with the S106 funding
- 2. The recent monthly report was considered and it was agreed that Cllr Hart would trim back the trees and the clerk would chase the maintenance contractor to progress work on repairing the path and applying anti-slip treatment to the climbing stack.
