As the District Councillor for Ermington and Ugborough, here is a flavour of the things I have been involved with over the past year on behalf of residents.

1. Planning matters – planning permission questions and enforcement issues including meeting residents to hear about their view on the proposed Aldi store in Ivybridge.
2. Social housing – in particular maintenance and disposal of social housing.
3. The allocation of s106 money to support local clubs, societies and for the benefit of residents.
4. Interactions with SHDH Environmental Health Department on behalf of residents.
5. Reporting and chasing removal of fly tips.
6. Liaising with DCC Highways about road improvements.
7. Supporting the allocation of tree preservation orders in the local area to protect trees from destruction.
8. Contributions to plans for active travel routes.
9. Chasing missed bin collections and intervening when bins are moved by the waste collection operatives.
10. Reporting and chasing removal of abandoned vehicles.
11. Allocation of locality fund to support local organisations.
12. Liaison with two ex-service personnel who needed support with local services.
